


NYÍREGYHÁZ ZOO (SÓSTÓ ZOO)

AQUARIUS ADVENTURE AND PARK BATHS

DISTANCE FROM TARCAL: 45 KM (47 MINUTES)

1.7 hectare bathing complex with wave pool, slides (kamikaze, family, giant, black hole, racing and elephant), white water drifting, children's pools, Inca ruin temple, treasure island.

ZEMPLÉN ADVENTURE PARK

DISTANCE FROM TARCAL: 49 KM (44 MINUTES)

The Zemplén Adventure Park is built on three terraces of the Magas Hill home to Hungary's longest single-cabin chairlift, the longest all-weather toboggan run and the longest and widest plastic-surface ski slope. The park's most exciting attraction is the Falcon 1 cable car, which takes you 100 metres up a 1-kilometre track at a top speed of 80 kilometres per hour. There is also an Adventure Park and a Climbing Wall Centre in the park.

Monday-Friday 10:00-18:00 Saturday-Sunday 9:00-18:00



CINEMAQUA FILM AND NATURE PARK, KISVÁRDA

DISTANCE FROM TARCAL: 83 KM (1 HOUR 15 MINUTES)





The film park covers almost 60 hectares, with more than 28 sectors. The different sectors are set in the original sets of films shot in Hungary, and each location offers a variety of attractions to discover, including the jungle of Jurassic Park, a pirate ship and the Wild West. Exciting programmes and exhibitions add even more colour to your time in the scenery.

The park is a real bucketlist attraction, which you can also visit by taking one of the specially designed electric buses.

DISTANCE FROM TARCAL: 61 KM (1 HOUR)

Passengers on the Pálházi small railway can get a glimpse of the fascinating wildlife of the Zemplén Landscape Protection Area. For more than 200 years, the Kemence stream valley has been the site of a small forest railway, providing unforgettable experiences for tens of thousands of visitors every year.
