






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GASTRONOMICAL EXPERIENCES

PICNIC

WINERY TOURS AND TASTINGS

WHERE THE WORLD FAMOUS WINE IS MADE...

A mysterious labyrinth system of cellars winds beneath the region's villages. This is where Tokaj wines are matured, the most outstanding of which is Tokaj aszú. Many historical figures, from Louis XIV to Goethe and Beethoven, have been fans of the drink. Many wineries and cellars in the area offer a behind-the-scenes look at wine production and winemaking, which is best crowned with a wine tasting.



Patrícius Wine House

Distance from Tarcal: 12 km (12 minutes)

Combining the richness of eight historic first-class vineyards, the 85-hectare estate's centre in Bodrogkisfalud, in the Várhegy vineyard, was built by converting the manorial press house featured in the 1867 Tokaj-Hegyalja Album, and now includes a modern gravity-flow winery built in organic style, perfectly reflecting the coexistence of tradition and modernity in the World Heritage landscape.

Höldvölgy Experience

Distance from Tarcal: 9 km (11 minutes)

Farmed on 28 hectares. The estate is situated in the most beautiful area of Tokaj-Hegyalja, in the most beautiful area of Mád, on 30 plots of 7 different vineyards. The ageing cellar with its 1.8km of passages is one of the oldest and longest cellar systems in the area, parts of which were built in the 15th century.

Disznókő Vineyard and Winery

Distance from Tarcal: 5,6 km (7 minutes)

The Disznókő estate takes its name from the Disznókő "vineyard", the first known written record of which dates back to 1413. The name 'Disznókő' refers to a large 'boar-shaped rock' in the heart of the estate, or according to some geographers, more accurately to the shape of the vineyard hill. The land, which produced exceptional quality wine, was once owned by noble families. Thanks to the knowledge accumulated over the decades and the experience gained in the production of Tokaj aszú, Disznókő is now considered a pioneer in the rebirth of great Tokaj wines.

WINERY TOURS AND TASTINGS

Kikelet Cellar

Distance: 550 m

The family winery covering 7 hectares is located in the heart of Tarcal, the oldest village in the Tokaj-Hegyalja wine region. For current prices, please contact our reception. Wine tastings are available on weekends without prior reservation and on weekdays by appointment. Accessible on foot.

Basilicus Vineyard

Distance: 600 m

The 8 hectare estate is spread over six vineyards, primarily in Tarcal, but also on the border with Bodrogkeresztúr and Tokaj, where all six grape varieties authorised in Tokaj - Furmint, Lime, Yellow Moss, Fat Grape, Zeta and Cabernet - and a pre-Filoxé blue grape, Purcsin, are cultivated organically. Fermented and sometimes matured mainly in barrels with minimal intervention and inoculated with yeast, the 10-12,000 bottles of wine produced each year often include seven to eight different types of wine, from dry cuvées and varietal wines to sweet, late-harvest wines, Samorodni, turnovers and aszú.

Seven Hills Distillery, Bodrogkisfalud

Distance from Tarcal: 7 km (13 minutes)

The region of Seven Hills is basically a whisky producing region, as it is the most suitable area in the country for the production of premium spirits for a number of reasons. Bobajka Restaurant

Első Mádi Borház, Mád

Distance from Tarcal: 8 km (10 minutes)

The first house in the village to welcome visitors arriving and passing through.

It is the first establishment that seeks to bring together and present in a dignified environment the essence of the work of the Mád winegrowers, their belief in the special sites of the Mád vineyards, the mineral-rich soil, the strict harvest limits, hard work and friendly cooperation. These wonderful wines are accompanied by a varied bistro kitchen that also uses the region's raw materials.

Percze Mád by Zip's, Mád

Distance from Tarcal: 10 km (12 minutes)

The team at Zip's has taken over the beautiful estate of Percze Restaurant Mád, overlooking the greenery and towers of the village, building on both the wine and the brasserie tradition. Dishes dreamed up with wine and beer make up a menu that is rich and indulgent.


Újhuta Castle
